Our very dear Friends and Supporters in Christ,

I am privileged to have been asked to do this end-of-year letter to you, and I do so with joy and thanksgiving for what has been an excellent year for the AESA Ministry.

Although this ministry has focused mainly on Johannesburg this year, nevertheless our amazing Foxfire team has ministered around the country in KZN, Mpumalanga and Limpopo, and beyond our borders in Eswatini (Swaziland) and Botswana. They reached, engaged with and addressed over 40 000 youngsters, and over 11 000 professed commitment to Christ. This is really wonderful, and my dream is to see a Foxfire Team in every major city of South Africa. It really could and should happen. But there is expansion next year insofar as we are starting a Foxfire team in Eswatini (Swaziland). I am very excited about this. There are chances too that next year the groundwork will be laid for a team in Johannesburg. I only share all this because I am excited about the South African ministry, and I long to see it expand significantly if the Lord would give us resources. Maybe one of you out there receiving this letter might find yourself saying, "you know what, I would

really love to put up the seed money for a new Foxfire team". What a rich and fruitful investment that would be! I am also very excited that our Bonginkosi ministry has really taken off in a new way under the shared leadership of Londeka Gasa and Linda Grant. They are two real champions and I praise the Lord for them.

Some good ministry still carries on at the AE Centre, although this is more of a struggle and needs lots of prayer and help. But I was greatly encouraged when I was there the other day and a lady, there for a conference, said to me, "this place is absolutely amazing and we have scores of testimonies of marvellous things God has done for people here.

I am very thankful that our great SA Team Leader, Theuns Pauw, has been able, after 7 very demanding years in the ministry, to take a few months of sabbatical break. He, Charlene and their family are away travelling with their camping trailer and having

what I know is a very restoring time. I am personally very thankful for Theuns' extensive gifts of preaching, teaching, admin, and finance. He is also immensely motivated and committed, and he works like a Trojan to keep the ministry on the road and advancing on many fronts. He will be back in April next year, and we wish all the Lord's blessings on him and his family during this time. Friends, I must say a word about finances. Our testimony of the Lord's faithfulness in this arena is really great, and our God has not let us down. Nor have you. But we sail

very close to the wind, and sometimes it is really nerve-wracking trying to meet all our

obligations. I think we are down at the moment quite a bit. So won't you please




